



The 2026 Quiet Corner Garden Club Annual Scholarships are awarded to local high school seniors or current college student pursuing a major in an agriculture/ horticulture-related field of study such as: Agronomy, Botany, City Planning, Conservation, Environmental Studies, Floriculture, Forestry, Horticulture, Land Management, Landscape Design, Plant Pathology, Aquaponics, Natural Resources and/or related subject. More than one scholarship may be awarded.

Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of academic achievement, leadership / initiative qualities, personal statement, community service, and letters of recommendation. See attached Rubric for more information.

Applicants must reside within the Quiet Corner Garden Club's service area of Northeastern Connecticut and South Central Massachusetts. [See QCGC [website](#) for qualifying residency [locations](#).]

In addition to the application form, the applicant must provide:

A transcript from your college or high school (current semester unofficial acceptable).

A personal statement addressing your qualifications for the scholarship, including career goals and commitment to chosen field of study. The statement should be no longer than one page, double-spaced.

- Two letters of recommendation (not from a family member).

High School Seniors: A copy of an acceptance letter from the college you plan to attend.

The application deadline is April 9, 2026.

Only **completed** applications received by that deadline are considered.

Applications will not be returned.

Recipients will be notified by May 15, 2026.

If awarded a scholarship you must submit your FALL transcript in December of 2026. The payment will be issued in January/February 2027).
